### NORFOLK COUNTY AUTUMN FOURSOMES 2014 RULES OF THE COMPETITION

#### Entry Conditions

- Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- Maximum combined handicap 52.
- Entry in pairs
- In the event of the competition being oversubscribed a ballot will be held and the remainder of entries will be placed on a waiting list in ballot order
- Entries received after the closing date will be placed on a reserve list and will only be used after the waiting list above has been exhausted.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- A CONGU Handicap Certificate for the current year must be produced before the end of the days play. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap – disqualification. Handicaps MUST be Competition/Active.

#### Conditions

- The Autumn Foursomes meeting shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Autumn Foursomes Organisers.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf 2012-2015, Appendix IV.5.
- The Autumn Foursomes Meeting shall consist of two 18 hole rounds – a 36 hole Stableford Foursomes (half combined handicap allowance) competition.
- Players may alter the order of teeing off from morning to afternoon.
- Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback.
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the committee will deduct two points from the total points scored for the round. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty under Rule 33-7 is DISQUALIFICATION.
- The Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the Organisers decision is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
