COUNTY MEDAL and BRISTER SALVER 2014 RULES OF THE COMPETITION

Entry Conditions

- Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- The handicap limit will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- Single entry with a flighted draw of handicaps PLUS TO 9 AND 10 TO 20.
- Entries to the Competition will be accepted in the order of receipt. If the event is oversubscribed, the remainder of entries will be placed on a waiting list in entry order.
- Entries received after the closing date will be placed on a reserve list and will only be used after the waiting list above has been exhausted.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- A CONGU Handicap Certificate for the current year must be produced before the end of days play. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap – disqualification. Handicaps MUST be Competition/Active.
- The Brister Salver is open to all players who have represented the County 2nd Team at any time with a current handicap of 15 or under (excluding 2013 First Team Players)

Conditions

- The County Medal/Brister Salver shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Divisional Organiser.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf 2012-2015, Appendix IV.5.
- The County Medal/Brister Salver shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round. Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback.
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in Stroke Play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, is DISQUALIFICATION.
- The Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the Organisers decision is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
