NORFOLK COUNTY DIVISION MEETINGS 2, 3 & 4 RULES OF THE COMPETITION 2014

Entry Conditions

- Only members of the NLCGA are eligible to enter
- The entry fee will be decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- The handicap limit will be as decided by the NLCGA Executive Committee.
- Single entry or in pairs
- Entries to the Competition will be accepted in the order of receipt. If the event is oversubscribed, the remainder of entries will be placed on a waiting list in entry order.
- Entries received after the closing date will be placed on a reserve list and will only be used after the waiting list above has been exhausted.
- No refund of entry fees will be given for cancellation within 14 days of the event.
- Any cancellations should be advised to the meeting organiser as soon as possible.
- A CONGU Handicap Certificate for the current year must be produced before the end of days play. Penalty for failure to produce proof of handicap – disqualification. Handicaps MUST be Competition/Active.

Conditions

- The Divisional Meetings shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules as may be approved by the Divisional Organiser.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted in accordance with the Rules of Golf 2012-2015, Appendix IV.5.
- Divisional Meetings II and III shall consist of one 18-hole stroke play qualifying round. Divisional Meeting IV shall consist of one 18-hole stableford qualifying round.
- Ties for prizes will be decided by card countback.
- If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the committee will add two strokes in medal play and deduct two points from the total points scored in a stableford. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty under Rule 33-7 is DISQUALIFICATION.
- The Organisers reserve the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In the event of adverse conditions the Organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
- In all matters the Organisers decision is final.
- Motorised buggies are permitted subject to the Transportation Policy of NLCGA.
- Caddies are permitted. NLCGA request that caddies do not go onto greens.
- Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddie.
